The requirements to become a member of the Fourth Degree are, be a three Degree member in good standing for one year and complete the Fourth Degree orientation requirements. Members of the Fourth Degree conduct programs that support and promote Patriotism including participation in Veteran's celebrations, fostering respect for the flag, as well as support for parish and community activities. Fourth Degree Knights provide a Color Guard wherever the Bishop appears at local parishes or when requested by our Pastors. They also provide Honor Guards for our deceased members family at Wakes and Funeral Masses.

Members of the Fourth Degree provide the visual public Presence of the Knights by appearing in parades and other ceremonies. Recent activities have included escorting the Bishop at the new Gates of Heaven Cemetery and participating in the Blessing of the Ocean Ceremony. Collectively they have raised funds for Most Blessed Sacrament School and Sponsored Seminarians.
